Target description

BCL7C (UniProt/Swiss-Prot entry Q8WUZ0) is homologous to the N-terminal region of BCL7A which was shown to be directly involved in a three-way gene translocation in a Burkitt lymphoma cell line. The function of BCL7A has not yet been elucidated, but it may play an anti-apoptotic role.




Figure 1 Determination of the titer

To determine the titer, an ELISA was performed using a serial dilution of the Diagenode antibody directed against human BCL7C (Cat. No. CS-124-100). The plates were coated with the peptides used for immunization of the rabbit. By plotting the absorbance against the antibody dilution (Figure 1), the titer of the antibody was estimated to be 1:209,000.



Western blot analysis using the Diagenode antibody directed against BCL7C

Nuclear extracts of HeLa cells (40 µg) were analysed by Western blot using the Diagenode antibody against BCL7C (Cat. No. CS-124-100) diluted 1:1,000 in TBS-Tween containing 5% skimmed milk. The position of the protein of interest is indicated on the right; the marker (in kDa) is shown on the left. The antibody detects both known isoforms of the protein (expected sizes: 23.4 and 26.4 kDa).
