Description: This primer pair specifically amplifies a genomic region from the Arabidopsis Actin gene. These primers are optimized for routine SYBR® Green Real-Time qPCR assay following ChIP

Amplicon length: 64 base pairs

Amplified region: chr5: 3,052,801-3,052,864 (UCSC Jan 2004)

Specificity: Arabidopsis thaliana

Format: 10 µM solution in MilliQ water (5 µM of each primer)

Storage: For long storage, store at -20°C. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles




Figure 1. ChIP was performed on Arabidopsis thaliana (Col-0) seedlings 14 days after germination (dag) using our premium anti-H3K27me3 ChIP-seq grade antibody (#C15410195) and rabbit IgG (#C15410206). Data shown is derived from biological replicates. Sheared chromatin from 0.2 g (fw) of seedlings was used per IP. Quantitative PCR was performed with the control FLC-Intron1 and Actin ATG primer sets from the kit. The recovery is expressed as % of input (the relative amount of immunoprecipitated DNA compared to input DNA after qPCR analysis).
